Instructions on Preparing the Posters

The time allocated for a poster presentation is 05 minutes, with a further 03 minutes allowed for discussion.

1. The poster size should be 61 cm x 91.5 cm - Portrait. In order to fit the poster board, your poster should not exceed the recommended size. Use the given template and it has been designed with above size and has shared pptx format for your convenience.
2. Your poster should include the abstract title and all authors at the top of the poster. The title lettering should not be less than a 48-point type.
3. Your poster should be readable from a distance of 2m. The body lettering should not be less than a 20-point type.
4. You may use graphs, tables and pictures as appropriately. Graphs, tables, graphic illustrations should be simple and more heavily drawn. The figures use needs to be in "High resolution photographs".
5. Make your poster aesthetically pleasing. Your poster should highlight and summarize the main points. A light background with dark lettering (preferably block style) is easiest to read.
6. Your poster should be self-explanatory so that you are free to supplement the information and discuss particular points raised by viewers during your presentation session.

Presenters participate physically.

Presenters required to present 30 minutes prior to the session along with the **printed poster**.

Presenters join virtually.

Upload the poster and the video (5 minutes) – <https://www.britae.lk/guidelines-for-abstract-submission-britae-2023/> on or before **Sunday March 12th, 2023**.

Rename uploaded files with Manuscript / abstract number.

Ex: BRITAE_SUTX_XX

Virtual presenters required to join the conference via zoom in the relevant session and should be available for the QA.
